

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL RULES

- TRAIL HOURS: SUNRISE TO SUNSET
- RIDE ONLY ON MARKED TRAILS
- OBSERVE: ONE-WAY ARROWS, DO-NOT-ENTER SIGNS AND TRAILS CLOSED SIGNS
- YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS
- CONTROL YOUR SPEED, PASS WITH CARE
- MAINTAIN A SAFE DISTANCE WHEN FOLLOWING ANOTHER BIKER
- KEEP ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS TO A MINIMUM
- STAY OFF WET OR SNOW COVERED TRAILS
- WEAR A HELMET

RESPECT THE WILDLIFE



Ramsey County Parks and Recreation Department in partnership with the Minnesota Off-Road Cyclists (MORC) have developed a revised mountain bike trail system at Battle Creek Regional Park. This trail system includes 3.3 miles of multi-use trails and 4.5 miles of single track mountain bike trails.

Mountain bikers are required to follow the rules outlined on the previous page. Trail maintenance and construction is performed by Ramsey County Parks and MORC at authorized events. It is illegal to construct new trails or modify existing trails. Notify Ramsey County Parks of any trail maintenance issues.

The trails are designed for recreational use only. At this present time, no races are permitted in order to establish a manageable trail system.

Battle Creek Regional Park is the only authorized trail system in the Ramsey County Park system. It is illegal to ride off trail in any other Ramsey County Park or open space.

Mountain Bike Trails and Rules for Battle Creek Regional Park



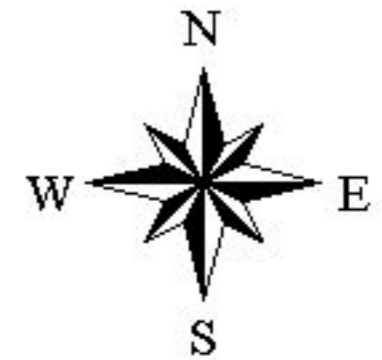
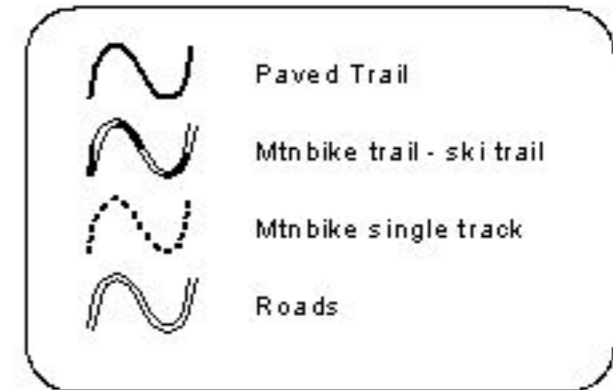
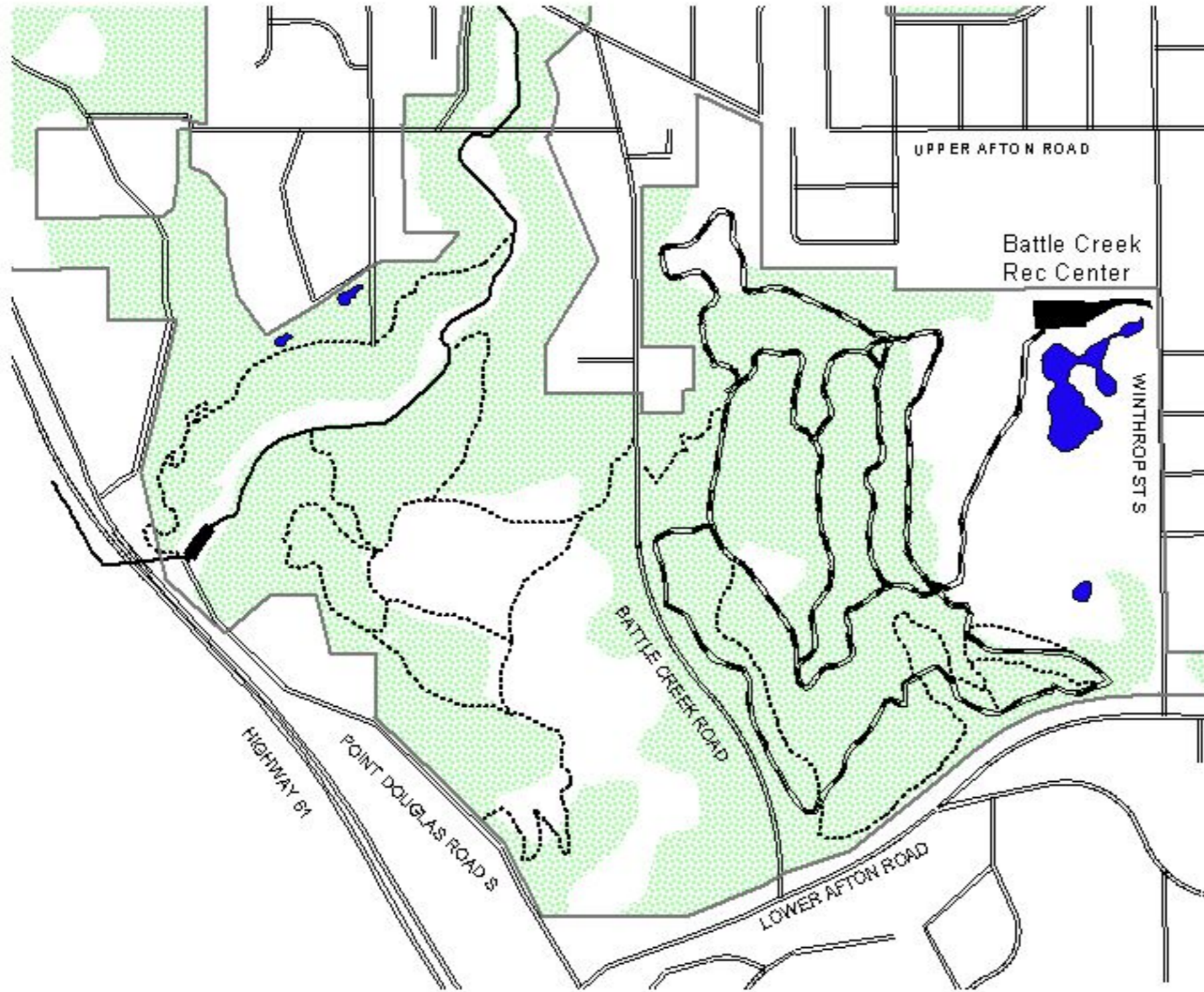
