



**LOCATION:** Harriet Alexander Nature Center is located at the east end of Roseville's Central Park. The center is located off Dale Street, between Co. Rd. C. and Co. Rd. B2. It can be reached by taking the Dale Street exit from Hwy 36 and going north approximately ½ mile. The center has a series of boardwalks. Paved trails connect to the rest of Central Park. MAP #: 13

**HABITAT:** The nature center consists of a large wetland. The wetland is a mixture of cattail marsh and shrub swamp. A mixed woodland surrounds the swamp. A small prairie is located near the building.

**REGULAR BIRDS:** From the boardwalks you can find Wood Ducks, Sora Rails, Marsh Wrens, Red-winged Blackbirds and Swamp Sparrows. The wooded edge is good for Northern Flickers and Song Sparrows.
