



LOCATION: Reservoir Woods is located in central Roseville. The park is divided by Dale Street. Parking is at the end of Alta Vista Dr. Alta Vista is off of Dale Street, just north of Larpenteur Ave. Parking is also available at the Woodview Open Space on Larpenteur Ave. A paved trail goes from Larpenteur Ave. to Victoria St. MAP #: 14

HABITAT: Reservoir Woods is a mixture of woodlands, wetlands and prairie. The woodlands are oak along the north border with a large pine plantation in the center. The woods east of Dale St. are mixed. The wetlands vary from wet meadows to a large open wetland in the Woodview Open Space. The prairie area is east of Victoria St. and north of the parking lot.

REGULAR BIRDS: Some of the birds using the woods include Great Horned Owls, Eastern Phoebe, Warbling Vireo, Baltimore Orioles and Red-breasted Nuthatches in the winter.
