



LOCATION: Pig's Eye SNA is located on an island at the south end of the Pig's Eye Peninsula. There is no road access to the island. The island can be viewed by boat. The closest launch is in South St. Paul, just south of the I-494 bridge. MAP #: 20

HABITAT: The island is flood plain forest dominated by cottonwoods and silver maples.

REGULAR BIRDS: The island is home to a large heron colony, which includes Great Blue Herons, Great Egrets, Black-crowned Night-Herons, and Double-crested Cormorants. Bald Eagles and Turkey Vultures also nest on the island.
