



LOCATION: Hidden Falls is located between Mississippi River Blvd. and the Mississippi River. It stretches from the Hwy 5 bridge north to the Ford Plant. The parking lots can be reached from Mississippi River Blvd, across from Prior Ave in the south and Magoffin St. at the north end. Paved trails connect it to Crosby Park. MAP #: 24

HABITAT: The park is a mixture of picnic areas, flood plain forest and mixed oak forest on the bluffs. Hidden Falls stream is found at the north end of the park. There is a line of limestone and sandstone outcrops on the east side of the park. It also has sandy shoreline of the Mississippi River.

REGULAR BIRDS: Peregrine Falcons nest just north of the park at the locks. Great Horned, Barred and Eastern Screech Owls can be found in the Park. Thrushes and warblers are common in migration.
