



LOCATION: Como Park is located in north central St. Paul. It is bounded by Hamline Ave. on the west and Como Lake on the east. Lexington Ave bisects the park. There are several parking lots on Lexington Ave and additional parking on Como Ave. There are a number of paved trails in the park and around the lake. The Como Zoo and Conservatory are also located in the park. MAP #: 25

HABITAT: The park is mainly large areas of turf grass with large mature trees. There are pockets of oak woods in the park. The shoreline of Como Lake has been restored to natives.

REGULAR BIRDS: This site has a good diversity of migrating warblers. The Lake is good for Common Loons and migratory waterfowl, especially in the spring. Cooper's Hawks and Great Horned Owls nest in the park.
