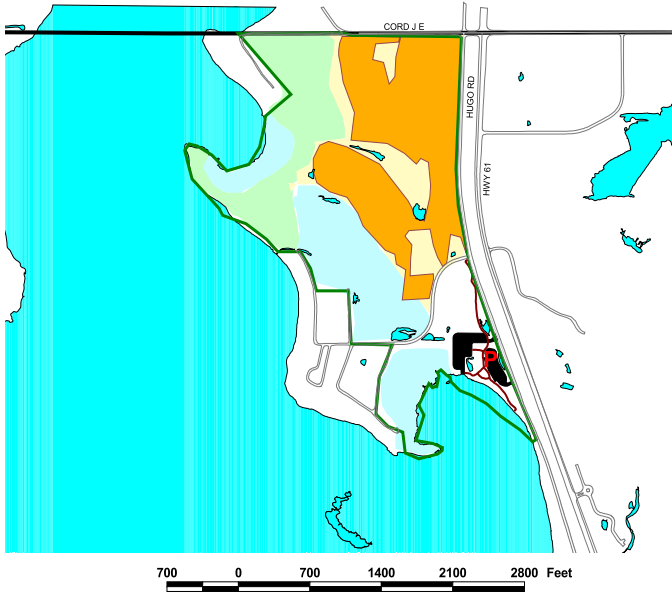


Bald Eagle - Benson Prairie



LOCATION: Bald Eagle - Benson Prairie is the northeast corner of Bald Eagle-Otter Lake Regional Park in White Bear Township. The east boundary is Hwy. 61 and the north boundary is the County Line. Park in the picnic area parking lot. Access is by mowed trails.

PRAIRIE FACTS: The 45-acre Benson Prairie is the newest prairie. It was planted in 2005 with grants from the Minnesota Wildlife Grant Program and the Metro Greenways program. It was planted with a sand prairie seed mix.

OTHER HABITATS: The south side of the prairie is bounded by a large cattail marsh. An oak woods borders the prairie and forms the shoreline of Bald Eagle Lake.
